## General Purpose Hand Course

This is an entry level training program for all persons who wish to work on a commercial vessel. No prior experience or training is required to undertake the course.

A General Purpose Hand (Deckhand) assists the Master and Engineer in the operational workings of the vessel.

The units marked with an \* below are all mandatory pre-sea training requirements for all sea-going personnel.

This course is delivered both electronically and with onboard practical training on a commercial vessel. Course enrolment can be undertaken at any time. Practical courses are held monthly.

Initially Enrolment: To commence your Deck Hand (GPH) training costs **\$395.00**. On completion of your initial enrolment you will receive all training manuals, be allocated a dedicated trainer and have access to our online assignments.

Final Course Costs: On completion of your initial enrolment you will be required to undertake practical training on our commercial training vessel for 2-3 days depending on class numbers. These practical sessions are held monthly. The final course cost for the practical sessions is **\$495.00**

The total cost to complete the General Purpose Hand course is **\$890.00**

Additional Costs: A current 1<sup>st</sup> Aid is required if you do not already possess one at an approx cost of **\$150.00** (You can complete 1<sup>st</sup> Aid with a provider of your choice)  
A Record of Service Book from NSW Maritime is required. Approx cost **\$27.00**
