INFORMATION SHEET SURVIVE AT SEA IN THE EVENT OF VESSEL ABANDONMENT

(TDMMF1107B)

LEARNING OUTCOMES:

Participants on successful completion of this course will:

- Understand relevant maritime regulations dealing with survival at sea following abandonment of vessel
- Understand initial actions when boarding survival craft to enhance the chance of survival
- Jump safely from a height into the water in accordance with established survival practice
- Swim while wearing a life-jacket and float without a life-jacket in accordance with established survival practice
- Right an inverted life raft while wearing a life-jacket in accordance with established survival practice
- Deploy sea anchors and drogues in accordance with accepted nautical practice
- Identify signs of hypothermia and treat in accordance with accepted survival medical practice
- Identify the location and accessibility of lifesaving and survival equipment is established
- Ensure the method of boarding survival craft is appropriate and avoids dangers to other survivors
- Gain knowledge and understanding of internationally recognised distress signals
- Understand the importance of regular drills to enhance survival
- Gain knowledge and understanding of emergency & safety equipment carried on board a vessel and in survival craft
- Gain knowledge and understanding of EPIRBS & SART's

- Enrolment in the course can be undertaken at any time and can be conducted on an individual or group session basis.
- The course is delivered through self study, online assessments and a 4 hour revision and 'practical' session
